Project: H2020 “RESTORE: User-centred smart nanobiomaterial-based 3D matrices for chondral repair”

INEB/i3S invites applications for 1 (one) position in the scope of the Project RESTORE: User-centred smart nanobiomaterial-based 3D matrices for chondral repair H2020-NMBP-22.2018 funded by the European Commission, with the following reference: **RESTORE_MCHS_01_2019**

Admission requirements: MSc in the areas of Project Management, Communication or Health Sciences

Desirable factors: i) Professional experience in the areas of project management and communication; ii) Knowledge/experience as a researcher in biomedical sciences; iii) Experience in the management of international collaborative projects, particularly FP7 or H2020; iv) Proficiency in English, written and spoken.

Plan of work: The successful candidate will perform tasks for the support in duties relating to project management, communication and dissemination, and exploitation tasks in the framework of the RESTORE project, to support the deployment of the project and activities in the research funding team, under supervision of Dr. João Cortez and co-supervision of Dr. Meriem Lamghari.

Jury: João Cortez, Meriem Lamghari, Raquel Gonçalves and Julio Borlido.

Evaluation: The criteria of evaluation are based on the curricular path. The assessment of the applicants' CV, in particular management and communication capacity, shall be based on the following criteria:

- a) Detailed CV (50%): management experience, particularly with relevance for project management and communication;
 - b) Motivation letter (20%): interest and motivation for the project management and communication (10%), English language skills and written communication abilities (10%);
 - c) Interview (30%): The first 3 candidates with higher classification will be interviewed.
- Candidate final classification system shall be given based on a scale 0-100.

Contract duration: 12 months, part-time with possibility to be renewed up to 36 months, upon performance assessment. The contract is expected to start in March/April 2019.

The contract will be regulated by the Portuguese Labor Law. The selected candidate will benefit from an excellent research environment.



Applications are open from the 4th until the 15th of February 2019.
