INEB/i3S is opening **1 (one) Research Fellowships (MSc)** in the scope of the Project Structured Programme on Bioengineering Therapies for Infectious Diseases and Tissue Regeneration, NORTE-01-0145-FEDER-000012, funded by “FEDER - Fundo Europeu de Desenvolvimento Regional” in the frame of “Norte2020 - Programa Operacional Regional do Norte”, with the following reference:

Admission requirements: The candidates should have a Master Degree in Bioengineering, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Biomedicine or equivalent (minimal classification of 15) and availability to start immediately.

Previous experience in the development and characterization of functionalized nanoparticles for biomedical applications, biopharmaceuticals, cell culture in tridimensional systems, immunocytochemistry, as well as analytical methods is essential.

The work will be developed in research line “New therapies for infectious diseases” in the Nanomedicines and Translational Drug Delivery group at INEB/i3S – Instituto Nacional de Engenharia Biomédica/Instituto de Investigação e Inovação em Saúde.

Selection of candidate: The candidates will be ranked based on curriculum vitae and motivation letter, taking into account previous requirements. In case the jury consider relevant, the 3 candidates with the best classification may be selected for an interview. Curriculum, previous experience in relevant topics of the project and interview will count with 30%, 30% and 40%, respectively. In case of absence of interview, curriculum and previous experience will count with 50% each.

Grant duration: 7 months. The fellowship is expected to start in June 2019.

Value for monthly allowance: € 980 according to table values of FCT regulations, in the country (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>) and will be paid monthly, preferably by bank transfer.
