INEB/i3S is opening **1** (one) Post-Doctoral Fellowship in the scope of the Project Structured Programme on Bioengineering Therapies for Infectious Diseases and Tissue Regeneration, NORTE-01-0145-FEDER-000012, funded by "FEDER - Fundo Europeu de Desenvolvimento Regional" in the frame of "Norte2020 - Programa Operacional Regional do Norte", with the following reference:

**Admission requirements:** The candidates should have a PhD in Bioengineering, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Biomedicine or equivalent and availability to start immediately.

Previous experience in the development and characterization of functionalized nanoparticles for biomedical applications, biopharmaceuticals, cell culture in tridimensional systems, molecular biology, immunocytochemistry, as well as analytical methods is essential.

The work will be developed in research line "New therapies for infectious diseases" in the Nanomedicines and Translational Drug Delivery group at INEB/i3S — Instituto Nacional de Engenharia Biomédica/Instituto de Investigação e Inovação em Saúde.

**Grant duration:** 3 months, with the possibility of renew for additional 3 months. The fellowship is expected to start in December 2018.

Value for monthly allowance: € 1490 according to table values of FCT regulations, in the country (<a href="http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores">http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores</a>) and will be paid monthly, preferably by bank transfer.
